Driver Information	● Drivers MUST hold a RACERS licence applicable to the class. ● It is the driver's responsibility to have ambulance cover on your medical insurance. It is not covered by SKCWA or Racers world. ● All Participants MUST sign in and agree to the indemnity relative to their role. ● Event MUST be operated in accordance with RACERS Event Operating Manual. ● Kart retrieval will be performed by designated vehicles. ● No Starting of engines under Shelters. ● Pushers need previous experience or have instruction from officials. and be over +16yrs. Must have enclosed shoes. ● No loading of vehicles in the paddock roadway. (in front of shelters) while events are in progress, a clearway for karts must be maintained. For early pickup take gear away to trailer. ●
